SESSION 1: GRADES 4K-8 – June 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 8:00 a.m. – 1:45 p.m. Daily

As in the past, students will rotate between subject areas with different teachers for Reading, Art, Phy-Ed, Computers and Music. There will be lots of hands-on activities and exploration of new technologies. Middle school students will rotate between subject areas with different teachers for Music, Computers, and Phy-Ed. Course descriptions include:

Book Munchers for Grade Level PK – 1/2

Come join us as we read fun stories, create some snacks, and take part in various activities that go with the stories.

Magnifico!! for Grade Level 2/3 – 5

Come learn the basics of the Italian language. We will learn basic Italian words through games, activities and lots of practice! Ciao.

5K-Music and Movement

Art

SESSION 2: GRADES 4K-8 – June 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 8:00 a.m. – 1:45 p.m. Daily

Students and teachers will work together collaboratively to produce various skits and plays. Students in grades 6-8 will have the choice to participate in the skit group or Tech. Ed activities.
