

# Gilmanton School District Breakfast and Hot Lunch Information 2016-2017

## **Important!**

- Ala carte is blocked for all students until there is a positive balance in the family meal account.
- Parents can choose to “never allow” ala carte charges by their children.
- Parents and/or students are responsible for monitoring their meal account balances on the Infinite Campus portal on a regular basis.
- Email messages will be sent out each Wednesday to remind parents when funds should be deposited into the account (make sure you share your email address with school).
- When the meal account balance is no longer positive, the school reserves the right to block ala carte charges without warning.
- Students may be denied breakfast or lunch if the family meal account balance is negative (you should send a sack lunch).
- Statements will be sent with mid-term and report card mailings to all families with low balances.

**Ala Carte Items** (Ala carte items ARE NOT included with the meal prices.) Available at high school cafeteria. Elementary students may purchase certain items\* when they are at MS/HS school cafeteria for breakfast. **Items offered and prices are subject to change.**

**Please send a minimum of \$25 per child to start the year, and then send on a regular basis to always keep a POSITIVE BALANCE in your family meal account.**

## **HOW WILL I KNOW WHEN MY FAMILY MEAL ACCOUNT BALANCE IS GETTING LOW?**

1. Email is the most reliable way to get the information to parents in a timely manner; therefore it is important to let the school know the email address you check at least once a week.
2. Parents with balances at \$15 or less are emailed weekly, usually each Wednesday.
3. Parents and/or students should check their meal account balances on the Infinite Campus portal.
4. Low balance portal notifications can be sent to your smartphone or iPod. (Contact school for information on how to set this up.)
5. Meal cutoff letters are mailed to parents with negative balances on Wednesdays, with the cutoff being the following Tuesday.

## **HOW SHOULD MEAL ACCOUNT PAYMENTS BE MADE?**

1. Use e-Check to pay online through the Infinite Campus portal. This will be a debit from your bank account (checking or savings). A \$2.50 convenience fee is charged for each transaction.
2. Use a credit card to pay online through the Infinite Campus portal. A \$2.50 convenience fee is charged for each transaction.
3. Cash or check can be mailed to school or sent with your child.
